

Program Overview

Big Dipper, a national auxiliary of Blue Star Mothers of America, Inc., annually offers educational assistance.

What You Need to Know!

Persons applying for educational assistance must be currently enrolled in a college or vocational school pursuing a degree or certificate at the time of award disbursement.

Application for JCEA includes a letter of recommendation, an original 350-400 word essay, and the completion of application forms and attachments.

ELIGIBILITY/LIMITATIONS FOR ASSISTANCE AWARD - Applicant must meet one or more of the following eligibility requirements:

- Active Duty U.S. Military, National Guard, or Reserve Member;
- Retired U.S. Military member or Veteran;
- Blue Star Mother of America, Inc. member in good standing
- Spouse of Active Duty U.S. Military or Veteran;
- Child or Grandchild of Active Duty U.S. Military or Veteran;
- Child or Grandchild of Blue Star Mothers of America, Inc. member in good standing or a Blue Daisy.

An applicant is ineligible if he/she has already received a JCEA award twice before, is enrolled in a military tech school or military academy, is receiving full military pay to attend school or is applying for funds for continuing Educational Class to maintain a certificate or license.

JCEA is <u>not</u> a scholarship or grant; it is educational assistance. The funds may be used for the traditional expenditures such as tuition, fees and books; however, the funds can be used for anything that advances the applicant's progress towards his/her educational goals – tutoring, laptop, parking permits, etc. The award check is written directly to the recipient.

YOU ARE OUR HEROES; YOUR SERVICE IS YOUR GPA ... If you would like detailed information about this program, please email <u>Treas.bd@bluestarmothers.us</u> to request an application packet. The next program cycle will begin in early Spring with a June application due date with awards being made in late August or early September.



CHAPTER MEMBERS: Please use this summary sheet to promote JCEA to eligible recipients. Remember, they don't have access to the national website to download the forms. This will give them a place to request the actual forms, or you can download and print the 2024 application forms yourself and provided them to potential applicants. CHAPTER PRESIDENTS: Remember that you will need to sign the applications. Please also make sure the application is complete at the time of your signature.



JCEA Application Deadline is upon us. Applications must be complete, signed by a Chapter President, and postmarked <u>no later</u> than June 29th.

THE ARCADIA AUCTION



Summer has arrived, and that means that Fun Night is just weeks away. Are you ready? Your Big Dipper Board is working hard to create a lot of FUN so that you can Get Your Kicks on Route 66.

In keeping with the Route 66 theme, our silent auction this year will be named after one of the famous stops in OK. Once you have arrived on Route 66 be sure to hit the Arcadia Round Barn (otherwise known as the silent auction). This barn has been around since 1898. It was built by "Big Bill" Odor and is 60 ft in diameter and 43 feet high. It is one of the community's most popular gathering places, as well as a popular stop along the route. Just like at the real Arcadia Barn, there will be lots of goodies for you gaze upon.

The Arcadia Auction will be two-fold this year. The first half will consist of items that will be part of our white bag auction. Each item will have a white bag next to it, and you just drop a ticket in the bag of the item you would like to win. The second half will be Silent Auction. Bid sheets with the item description, donor and approximate value will be located in front of those items. You simply print your name, chapter number, cell phone number and bid. Pens will be provided for those of you who choose to bid on our amazing goodies.

Tickets for the Arcadia White Bag Auction are available for a donation once you have passed through the Welcome Center. Tickets are available in the following quantities: 1 for \$1,, 6 for \$5, 12 for \$10, or 25 or \$20. Once you have your tickets, please make sure to print your name and cell phone number on the back. If you are not still traveling along Route 66 at the time the ticket is drawn, do not fear.
