

# **Quilt Blocks**

We provide you with a starter fabric piece, you will then add your own to make a finished quilt block measuring 9-1/2 inches by 9-1/2 inches to allow for the seam allowance to complete the 9"x9" placement block for the quilt. You can choose to finish the block or have us finish it for you.

We are hoping to have enough quilt blocks to make two quilts. You can choose which theme/themes you would like to do. Red, White, & Blue Patriotic theme or Sisterhood Togetherness Theme. (Brown, Green, Blue)
